

ARIZONA JUDICIAL COUNCIL  
ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON CHILD SUPPORT

Administrative Order No. 92- 31

In accordance with Administrative Order No. 90-13, the Chief Justice may appoint advisory committees of the Arizona Judicial Council to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities. Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. An advisory committee on child support is hereby established as a committee of the Arizona Judicial Council and shall be known as the Advisory Committee on Child Support. This Committee is created to: 1) assist the Arizona Judicial Council and the Arizona Supreme Court in recommending a method, or methods, to account for second household expenses when calculating the child support amount; and, 2) recommend an approach to gather or develop Arizona data on costs of raising children in non-intact families.

2. The Chief Justice shall appoint Committee leadership as needed to organize Committee affairs. Sub-committees to help the Committee carry out its responsibilities may be appointed by the chairperson.

3. Under the direction of the Chief Justice, the Administrative Office of the Courts shall provide staff for the Committee and may conduct or coordinate management and research studies of judicial administration as recommended by the Committee.

4. The individuals named on the attached list are appointed as members. All members will serve until replacements are appointed or the committee is disbanded.
