Having been advised by the Administrative Director of the Courts that the situation requiring Administrative Order 93-37 existing in the above captioned court appears to have been resolved and that normal court operations may resume.

NOW THEREFORE, Administrative Order 93-37 is rescinded.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Office of the Courts shall issue a report making recommendations as needed which would assist the court in conducting its administrative operations. A copy of the report shall also be sent to Acting Presiding Judge Michael J. Brown of Pima County who should assist in seeing that the Municipal Court in Marana operates in a proper manner.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Marana Municipal Court, and all employees thereof, including the judge, the clerk, the deputy clerks, all employees of the court, and any agents or representatives of any of the foregoing named individuals, shall continue to cooperate with, and provide to, employees of the Administrative Office of the Courts, such documents and court records as may be necessary for future reviews or audits of operations of the court.
