The Supreme Court, having administrative supervisory authority and responsibility over all courts of the state pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, reviews and audits court operations periodically and in response to requests and complaints.

The Administrative Office of the Courts and the Commission on Judicial Conduct having received numerous complaints about the operation of the South Phoenix Justice Court and being in the process of reviewing other courts in Maricopa County,

Having placed the South Phoenix Justice Court and the Maricopa Justice Court Administration under the administrative authority of the Presiding Judge of Maricopa County, Honorable C. Kimball Rose, to ensure the proper independent operation of the justice courts in Maricopa County, and

Wanting to identify and correct any legal, ethical and administrative operational problems,

## IT IS NOW ORDERED THAT:

William A. Holohan, Chief Justice, Retired, is hereby appointed special counsel to assist the Administrative Director of the Courts in conducting a review of the Maricopa County Justice Court system.

As special counsel Judge Holohan shall have access to any and all Maricopa County justice court facilities, records and personnel.

All judiciary personnel shall cooperate with the special counsel and the Administrative Director shall assign personnel to assist the special counsel in the performance of his duties.

The special counsel shall make recommendations and assist the Presiding Judge of Maricopa County and the Administrative Director regarding the operation of the Maricopa County Justice Courts.
