On the recommendation of the State-Federal Judicial Council, in keeping with the long-standing tradition of comity and cooperation between the state and federal courts in the State of Arizona, and in accordance with the apparent intent of A.R.S. § 8-208(C) to include federal magistrate judges among those authorized to obtain a juvenile's records,

IT IS ORDERED that, on request for a juvenile's record made on behalf of the United States Attorney's Office for compliance with 18 U.S.C. § 5032 and for presentment to the federal magistrate judge for the purpose of a determination of release from custody, bond, and pretrial status, the Juvenile Court shall promptly release to the United States Attorney's Office all information in its possession constituting the juvenile's record.
