CREATION OF THE ARIZONA JUDICIAL COUNCIL COMMITTEE ON COURT REPORTERS

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 95-16

The purpose of this committee is to examine the employment relationship between the Arizona court system and court reporters;

IT IS ORDERED the committee will review the applicable provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act and related opinions from the Department of Labor's legal staff and recommend how Arizona courts can best comply with the current Federal law;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the committee will make recommendations on how Arizona courts can best avoid Worker's Compensation claims related to carpel-tunnel syndrome, which is associated with excessive repetitive motions; review the employment options available to the court reporters and make recommendations on how Arizona courts can best employ and compensate court reporters. The committee will also review the current use of court reporters and other methods to prepare a record of court proceedings including audio, video and real time transcription and recommend when each type of technology should be utilized.
