On June 6, 1990, by Revised Administrative Order No. 90-13, the Supreme Court adopted the policies governing the Arizona Judicial Council (AJC) which included a provision under section 1.g. for AJC members to designate another "to serve as his or her proxy on motions before the Council."

At the December 20, 1995, meeting of the AJC, the Council requested that the Court eliminate the ability of the Arizona Judicial Council and its committees to designate a proxy; therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Revised Administrative Order No. 90-13 shall be amended to delete the provision under section 1.g. which allows a member of the Arizona Judicial Council to designate another to serve as their proxy on motions before the Council.

It is further ORDERED that the elimination of proxy designation for the AJC shall also apply to all the committees of the Arizona Judicial Council
