

SOUTHERN ARIZONA DESIGNATED POST OF DUTY Administrative Order No. 96-⁷⁰

The Supreme Court has administrative responsibility over the Arizona judicial department which is comprised of appellate, superior, justice, and municipal courts located throughout the state. One hundred and thirty-six of these 183 courts are located outside of the Phoenix metropolitan area. Accordingly, it is in the public interest and in the interest of the judiciary for the Supreme Court to designate one or more member's post of duty outside of the Phoenix metropolitan area.

Now, therefore, pursuant to the administrative authority vested in the Supreme Court by Arizona Constitution, Article VI, Section 3,

IT IS ORDERED that Justice Stanley G. Feldman is designated as a member of this Court whose designated post of duty shall be located in Tucson, effective January 1, 1997. Any expenses for travel to and from his designated post of duty shall be computed in accordance with the regulations and policies applicable to court travel in general, so that expenses for travel, meals and lodging when away from the designated post of duty shall be reimbursed in the normal manner.
