

Administrative Order  
No. 97- 9  
(Rescinding 97-6)

The Supreme Court, having administrative supervision over all courts of the state pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, periodically conducts reviews and audits of operations.

Pursuant to the foregoing authority, the Supreme Court ordered that the Administrative Director of the Courts, or his designees, assume administrative control of the Clifton Justice and Municipal Courts and immediately secure the court and its records, on January 16, 1997, to conduct an operational review. The on-site operational review was completed on January 31, 1997, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order 97-6 shall be rescinded.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Director of the Courts, or his designee, shall immediately return administrative control of the Clifton Justice and Municipal Courts, including constructive possession of all books and records, to the Clifton Justice of the Peace and Magistrate.
