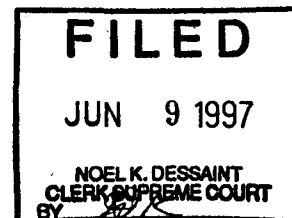

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 97- 26

Pursuant to Article 6, Section 42 of the Arizona Constitution, and Rule 2 (a) and (b) of the Rules of Procedure for Judicial Performance Review in the State of Arizona, the Supreme Court is responsible for appointing members to the Commission on Judicial Performance Review. Attorney member J. William Brammer recently was appointed a judge of the appellate court; therefore, it is necessary to appoint a replacement to fulfill the unexpired term of Judge Brammer.

IT IS ORDERED that Andrew M. Federhar is appointed as a member of the Commission on Judicial Performance Review to hold the position for a term beginning on this date and ending on December 31, 1999.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Mr. Federhar ceases to hold the position indicated or for any other reason is unable to serve until the expiration of his term, the vacancy shall be filled by a qualified new appointee to serve the unexpired term.
