

APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON JUVENILE MISDEMEANOR OFFENSES

Administrative Order No. 97-<u>36</u>

Pursuant to session law enacted during the 1997 legislative session known as Juvenile Justice Reform, Misdemeanor Offenses and Diversion (Chapter 220, SB 1446), the Arizona Supreme Court is authorized to appoint four members representing the judiciary: one justice of the peace, one municipal court judge, one juvenile court judge and a representative of the Administrative Office of the Courts to the Joint Legislative Committee on Juvenile Misdemeanor Offenses.

IT IS ORDERED that the individuals named below are appointed to the Joint Legislative Committee on Juvenile Misdemeanor Offenses with their terms beginning on July 21, 1997, and ending on December 31, 1997, or when the Committee's final report to the Legislature, Governor and Chief Justice of the Supreme Court is submitted.
