

APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS-AT-LARGE TO THE STATE FOSTER CARE REVIEW BOARD

Administrative Order No. 98-<u>15</u> (Revising Administrative Order No. 98-6)

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 8-515.04, the Arizona Supreme Court is responsible for appointing members to the State Foster Care Review Board. On February 5, 1998, the Court appointed three 'members-at-large,' Jannah Scott, Angela Ashley and Alice Van Stockum, to the State Foster Care Review Board for three-year terms to expire on January 15, 2001. The Court has been advised that the three-year term expiration dates named in Administrative Order 98-6 are inconsistent with the State Foster Care Review Board's established term rotation schedule. In keeping with the established rotation schedule, the three members should have been appointed for two-year terms.

It is the desire of the Court to revise the length of the terms of Jannah Scott, Angela Ashley and Alice Van Stockum, appointed members of the State Foster Care Review Board, from three years to two years. Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order 98-6 is amended to revise the term expiration dates for the three members of the State Foster Care Review Board from January 15, 2001, to January 17, 2000.
