

APPOINTMENT OF MEMBER TO THE COMMISSION ON TECHNOLOGY Administrative Order No. 98-<u>33</u>

On February 11, 1998, by Administrative Order No. 98-12, Judge William E. Druke, Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals, Division II, was appointed as a member of the Commission on Technology. The term of his membership on the Commission is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2000. Judge Druke is unable to fulfill his membership term on the Commission and has resigned. The Commission desires to appoint Judge Joseph Howard to complete the unexpired term of Judge Druke.

In accordance with Administrative Order No. 98-9 (revising and replacing Administrative Order No. 90-21 establishing the Commission on Technology), the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing members who do not serve by virtue of their position. Now therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Judge Joseph Howard is appointed as a member on the Commission on Technology to complete the unexpired term of Judge William E. Druke which ends on June 30, 2000.
