

In accordance with Rule 47, Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, the Court is responsible for appointing members of the Arizona Supreme Court Disciplinary Commission. On July 22, 1998, the Court appointed Charles Alan Bowman to fill the expired term of Richard Goldsmith, and Bettye Wilson to fill the vacancy created by Denis Malm's resignation.

It has come to the attention of the Court that Mr. Bowman should have been appointed to fill the seat created by the resignation of Denis Malm, and that Ms. Wilson should have been appointed to fill the seat created by the expired term of Richard Goldsmith. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Charles Alan Bowman is appointed to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Denis Malm and shall serve a three-year term beginning on October 1, 1998 and ending on September 30, 2001.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Bettye Wilson is appointed to fill the expired term of Richard Goldsmith and shall serve a three-year term beginning on October 1, 1998 and expiring on September 30, 2001.
