Pursuant to the Policies of the Arizona Judicial Council, all Council members not holding membership by virtue of their position are appointed by the Chief Justice.

On August 14, 1998, by Administrative Order No. 98-44, Judge Edward L. Dawson was reappointed to the Arizona Judicial Council filling a membership roster requirement for "presiding judge of Superior Court in a rural county." Judge Dawson's term as presiding judge will expire on December 31, 1998, thus, he will not be eligible to fulfill his term on the Council which expires June 30, 2000.

In accordance with Administrative Order 90-13, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing members of the Arizona Judicial Council and, after due consideration by the Court,

IT IS ORDERED that Judge Tom C. Cole, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Yuma County, is hereby appointed to fulfill the unexpired term of Judge Edward L. Dawson from January 1, 1999, to June 30, 2000.
