

Administrative Order
No. 99- 4

Pursuant to Rule I (4) of the Uniform Rules of Practice of the Superior Court of Arizona, and Administrative Rule V-A I.B. (4) of Administrative Order 93-30 (Revised), the presiding judge in each county shall appoint with the approval of the Supreme Court an associate presiding judge to act during the absence or unavailability of the presiding judge.

On January 4, 1999, by Administrative Order 99-2 of the Superior Court in Pima County, the Honorable Gordon Alley, Presiding Judge, appointed the Honorable Leslie Miller as Associate Presiding Judge.

Now, therefore, in accordance with the provisions of Uniform Rules of Practice and Administrative Rule V-A cited herein,

IT IS ORDERED that the Court hereby approves the appointment of the Honorable Leslie Miller as Associate Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Pima County and, in accordance with Rule I (7) (b), she shall serve at the pleasure of the presiding judge and exercise and discharge all powers and duties of the presiding judge, except that she may not appoint court commissioners or appoint judges permanently to special assignments.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order is effective nunc pro tunc to January 4, 1999.
