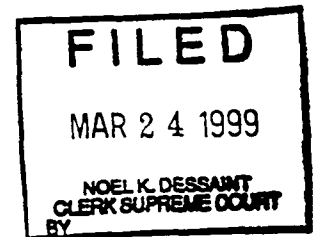

Administrative Order  
No. 99- 21  
(Revising Administrative  
Order 97-54)

On October, 1997, by Administrative Order No. 97-54, the Committee to Study Family Issues in the Courts was established to examine the manner in which cases involving family issues were processed and determined in the Superior Court, and directed to present a final report of its findings to the Arizona Judicial Council (AJC) at the October 1998 meeting.

On December 16, 1998, the Committee again appeared before the Council and, at that time, the AJC directed the Committee to add additional members representing the family law section of the State Bar, and to report its findings to the Council at the October 1999 meeting.

In accordance with Administrative Order No. 97-54, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing members of the Committee to Study Family Issues in the Superior Court.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,
