PRO TEMPORE ORDER

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Coconino County has requested the appointment of a court commissioner to serve as a judge pro tempore in that court for the purpose of enhancing the court's ability to process cases. Therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141,

IT IS ORDERED that Margaret McCullough, State Bar #007159, is appointed judge pro tempore to serve the Superior Court in Coconino County for a term beginning January 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2007, in accordance with A.R.S. §§ 12-141 et. seq., and will serve as assigned by the presiding judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment is conditioned upon the approval of the Coconino County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the agreement by the appointee to serve for no compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise, as provided in A.R.S. § 12-142(C) for service as a judge pro tempore.
