PRO TEMPORE ORDER

The presiding judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County has requested the appointment of an out-of-state judge to serve for a designated day, and the judge has agreed to serve without compensation for the day of service and to indemnify and hold the State of Arizona and the County harmless from any and all claims, causes of action, liability, loss, cost or expenses, including reasonable attorney fees, arising out of and resulting from the judge's services and actions as a judge *pro tempore*. Therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 12-141 et seq.,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Thomas M. McCormack, a judge of the Superior Court of New Jersey, is appointed as judge *pro tempore* to serve the Superior Court in Maricopa County on Saturday, February 24, 2007, for the purpose of performing a marriage ceremony.
