PRO TEMPORE ORDER

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County has requested the appointment of the Honorable Robert Gottsfield and the Honorable Bernard Dougherty, formerly judges of that court and now retired, to serve as judges pro tempore in that court for the purpose of enhancing the court's ability to process cases. Therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141,

IT IS ORDERED, nunc pro tunc, that the Honorable Robert Gottsfield and the Honorable Bernard Dougherty are appointed as judges pro tempore to serve the Superior Court in Maricopa County for terms beginning January 17, 2007, and ending June 30, 2007, in accordance with A.R.S. §§ 12-141 et. seq., and will serve as assigned by the presiding judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these appointments are conditioned upon the approval of the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the Superior Court in Maricopa County obtaining appropriate funding from whatever source for the compensation due to said appointees pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and § 12-143 for service as judges pro tempore.
