**DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION  
REPORT**

This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on October 15, 2005, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Hearing Officer's Report filed April 7, 2005 recommending acceptance of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Tender) and Joint Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum) providing for a censure, two years of probation with the State Bar's Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP), the State Bar's Member Assistance Program (MAP), and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.

**Decision**

The nine members of the Disciplinary Commission unanimously recommend accepting and adopting the Hearing Officer's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation for censure, two years of probation (LOMAP, including a practice monitor,<sup>1</sup> MAP) and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.<sup>2</sup> The State Bar shall notify the Disciplinary Clerk of the date of commencement of probation. The terms of probation are
