8 This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of  
9 Arizona on July 9, 2005, pursuant to Rule 58, Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the  
10 Hearing Officer's Report filed April 15, 2005 recommending acceptance of the Tender of  
11 Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Agreement) and Joint Memorandum  
12 in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum) providing for a  
13 censure, one year of probation effective upon the signing of the probation contract with the  
14 State Bar's Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP), a practice monitor, fee  
15 arbitration and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.

17 **Decision**

18 The nine members of the Commission unanimously recommend accepting and  
19 incorporating by reference the Hearing Officers' findings of fact, conclusions of law and  
20 recommendation for a censure, one year of probation effective upon the signing of the  
21 probation contract with LOMAP, a practice monitor and fee arbitration, and costs of these  
22 disciplinary proceedings.<sup>1</sup> The terms of probation are as follows:
