The Disciplinary Commission having filed a Report in the above-captioned matter,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) Respondent, MARK HYATT TYNAN, is hereby reprimanded for conduct in violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct, Rule 42, Ariz. R. S. Ct., specifically: ERs 5.5 and 8.4(a) and (d).


(2) Pursuant to Rule 60(a)5, Ariz. R. S. Ct., Respondent shall be placed on probation for a period of two years, effective upon the signing of the probation contract. Bar Counsel shall notify the Disciplinary Clerk of the date on which the probation begins. The terms and conditions of probation are as follows:

a.) Respondent shall meet with the director of the Member Assistance Program (MAP), who will conduct an assessment. Respondent will thereafter enter into a probation contract based upon the recommendations made by the director of MAP.

b.) Respondent will provide proof of ongoing medical treatment. Respondent will continue to receive what medical treatment is recommended by his treating physicians and will waive his right to confidentiality of medical records and/or provide evidence of ongoing treatment so that his medical treatment can be monitored by the State Bar.

(3) Pursuant to Rule 60(a)4, Ariz. R. S. Ct., this Order will be entered in the Respondent's permanent record and, pursuant to Rule 70, is not confidential. It may also be considered by a hearing officer, the Disciplinary Commission or the Supreme Court in recommending or imposing discipline in a subsequent disciplinary proceeding against Respondent, pursuant to Rule 48(k)3, Ariz. R. S. Ct.
