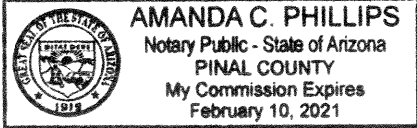

I'm writing this letter of interest in regards to the Independent Redistricting Commission (IRC). I have been a resident of Arizona for the last 38 years. My wife and I have raised our three children in the same house in Chandler for 23 years. I have been involved in the financial services/banking industry since 1996. Shortly after getting my degree in Business Management from Ottawa University, I earned a job as a Bank Manager. I have held various positions in Finance/Banking for the last 26 years.

During those 26 years of work, I have served on several boards in various capacities, including various HOA and children's sports related boards. I was on the board for the United Food Bank from 2011 to 2014. I joined the board with the intention of helping serve the East Valley Community. Specifically, during my time on the board, we created various "plans" to ensure that children in the East Valley had access to healthy food choices when not in school. In addition, we secured a large warehouse facility to help with food storage and facilitate the distribution of various foods to hungry individuals. I was voted in as Treasurer from 2013-2014.

I was recently appointed to the Chandler Industrial Development Authority (IDA). The goal of the IDA is to promote manufacturing, industrial and commercial enterprises to locate and remain with the City of Chandler. The IDA offers low interest loans for qualifying projects via the issuance of tax-exempt bonds. Members serve 6 year terms. I was appointed in May of 2020.
