OnBase Desktop Client

- Warning: The Desktop Client is no longer supported in <u>OnBase 17</u> or newer
 - The Desktop Client is the primary method for document retrieval for AZTEC
 - Some local systems use it, too
- The AOC is developing integration with the OnBase Unity Client as a replacement
 - This will include replacing Disconnected Scanning with the Unity Client which will enable real-time scanning
 - WOB.exe is being updated by DataBank for continued AZTEC support in V17

Upgrade OnBase

- OnBase will need to be upgraded to continue participation in any of the eCourt products
 - Addresses reported security vulnerabilities per Hyland
 - Contains needed DTM bug fixes and restores broken functions
 - Now tracks locked documents missing from any transfer
 - eAccess, eBench, and eFiling depend on DTM to display documents
- Upgrade to version 17.0.0.36
 - The AOC is testing OnBase 17 and upgrading CDR asap
 - Will require separate app servers for V15 and V17 as courts upgrade

All 13 Superior Courts are now contributing to the CDR

- DataBank to help obtain password change utility
- Coordinate change with clerk and AJACS users
- AOC investigating integrated vendor security product
 - KOMpliance

Statewide Contract Update

- Current term ends 8/4/17 but extension has been signed
 + posted at //ajinweb/edms
- Investigated AZ SPO CDW-G software contract
 - Includes OnBase software licenses but <u>no</u> related services
- DataBank passed along Hyland price increases from 2015 and 2016 on client licenses, PDI, and Disc. Scanning
 - Will increase courts'/counties' maintenance cost after 8/4/17
 - Investigating enterprise pricing options, but likely require single payer
