The Presiding Disciplinary Judge (“PDJ”) having accepted the Consent to Disbarment submitted pursuant to Rule 57(a), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., and reviewed the State Bar Statement of Costs and Expenses filed May 5, 2025¹ proceeded with issuing a Final Judgement and Order of Disbarment, signed and filed on May 13, 2025. It has come to the PDJ’s attention that the State Bar filed a Notice of 60(d), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. Request by Respondent (“Notice”) on May 13, 2025.

Having reviewed the Notice and the companion documentation, the PDJ finds good cause to withdraw/vacate the Final Judgement and Order of Disbarment filed on May 13, 2025 in its entirety and issue this Amended Order reflecting the State Bar’s amended request of actual expenses incurred in this matter. **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED vacating the Final Judgement and Order of Disbarment filed on May 13, 2025 and Ordered replacing such with this Amended Final Judgment and Order as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that **TREVOR S. His name is stricken from the roll of lawyers in Arizona, and he is no longer entitled to the rights and privileges of a lawyer, though he remains subject to the jurisdiction of the court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall pay the actual expenses of the State Bar of Arizona in the amount of \$82.50 within 30 days. There are no costs or expenses incurred by the Office of the Presiding Disciplinary Judge in these proceedings.

ORDER OF DISBARMENT

Pursuant to Rule 57(a)(5), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., Respondent Trevor S. Draegeth who is self-represented, has filed a consent to disbarment in the form required by the rule on April 22, 2025. The Presiding Disciplinary Judge (PDJ) has also reviewed the Notice of No Opposition and Withdrawal of Moot Motion for Interim Suspension filed April 25, 2025. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED disbarring **TREVOR S. DRAGETH., Bar No. 027464**, effective immediately. His name is stricken from the roll of lawyers in Arizona, and he is no longer entitled to the rights and privileges of a lawyer, though he remains subject to the jurisdiction of the court. Any future application for admission or reinstatement will be treated as an application by a member who has been disbarred for professional misconduct, as set forth in State Bar File No. 19-0676. No further disciplinary action shall be taken in reference to this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Rule 57(a)(5)(B), Respondent shall immediately comply with the requirements of Rule 72, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., relating to notification of clients and others.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED deeming the State Bar's Motion for Interim Suspension filed April 21, 2025 is moot.

Pursuant to Rule 60 (d), an assessment of costs and expenses related to disciplinary proceedings shall be imposed upon the respondent,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the State Bar shall file an itemized statement of costs and expenses and serve a copy on respondent and the disciplinary clerk within five (5) days and a Final Judgement and Order shall issue thereafter.



I further acknowledge that I do not desire to contest or defend the charges but wish to consent to disbarment.

I have been advised of and have had an opportunity to exercise my right to be represented in this matter by a lawyer. I consent to disbarment freely and voluntarily and not under coercion or intimidation. I am aware of the rules of the Supreme Court with respect to discipline, disability, resignation and reinstatement, and I understand that any future application by me for admission or reinstatement as a member of the State Bar of Arizona will be treated as an application by a member who has been disbarred for professional misconduct.
