

Excellence in Education Awards

The Committee on Judicial Education and Training (COJET) annually recognizes the efforts of outstanding faculty and curriculum developers who represent the various divisions within the court system: judicial officers, probation/detention officers and staff, judicial court staff, managers, and executives.

The awards are presented to recipients by the following three standing COJET committees:

- 1) Judicial College of Arizona (JCA) – judicial officers
- 2) Committee on Probation Education (COPE) – probation/detention officers and staff
- 3) Committee on Leadership and Workforce Excellence (COLAWE) – court managers, executives, and all other judicial staff

Any judicial branch employee or committee member can nominate an individual or team demonstrating excellence in the development of curriculum and/or the delivery of a training at any time during the year; however, the nominees must be court employees.
