Pursuant to this Court's August 13, 2024 Order, nominal party Secretary of State Adrian Fontes provides notice that the Secretary's deadline to finalize the language of the publicity pamphlet required by A.R.S. § 19-123(A) is August 29, 2024.

In addition, the Secretary's counsel has consulted with counsel for both the Republican and Democratic Members of the Legislative Council, who have informed undersigned counsel that if a meeting of the Council is required following this Court's decision, the Council would hold a quorum call to determine when the requisite number of members of the 14-member committee can attend and must provide public notice at least 24 hours in advance of the new meeting date. The Republican Council member Appellees' attorney has further informed undersigned counsel that they are working to secure the necessary quorum to meet before the August 29 deadline. If a quorum of the council is available to meet on August 28, a decision issued on August 26 or early in the day on August 27 would permit the necessary 24-hour public notice in advance of the meeting. If Legislative Council is able to identify a meeting date and time when they believe that they will have a quorum that differs from the information above, they will notify the Court promptly.
