O R D E R

On February 17, 2023, the Court denied the American Civil Liberties Union/American Civil Liberties Union's (ACLU/ACLUAZ) motion for leave to file brief as *amici curiae* due to the brief failing to comply with the Court's January 31, 2023 and February 8, 2023, orders, and Ariz. R. Crim. P. 31.15(d)(2). The Court did grant leave for ACLU/ACLUAZ to refile its *amici* brief and motion in compliance with the Court's prior orders and Ariz. R. Crim. P. 31.15(d)(2) at or before 12:00 p.m. on February 21, 2023.

On February 21, 2023, after the Court's 12:00 p.m. deadline, the ACLU/ACLUAZ filed a *Refiled Motion of American Civil Liberties Union and American Civil Liberties Union of Arizona for Leave to File a Brief as Amici Curiae and Brief of Amici Curiae American Civil Liberties Union and American Civil Liberties Union of Arizona*. In addition, ACLU/ACLUAZ filed a *Motion of American Civil Liberties Union and American Civil Liberties Union of Arizona for Leave to File Brief of Amici Curiae After Court's Noon Deadline* stating "[t]he delay arose from a calendaring error and was not an intent to disregard the Court's Order."
