Pursuant to Rule 17, Ariz. R. Civ. App. P., Plaintiff-Appellant Planned Parenthood Arizona, Inc. (“PPAZ”) submits the following supplemental authorities in support of its May 1, 2024 Motion for Stay of Issuance of Mandate.

First, H.B. 2677 was signed by Governor Katie Hobbs on the afternoon of May 2, 2024. A true and correct copy of the fully-executed legislation is attached as **Exhibit 1**. This is relevant to the entire Motion, and PPAZ previewed its eventual filing on page 4, footnote 4.

Second, PPAZ notes that as members of the Arizona Senate explained their votes, Senator Priya Sundareshan spoke to the fact that the passage of H.B. 2677 was a “clear statement that the Legislature does not want the Territorial Ban to be enforceable.” *See* May 1, 2024 Arizona Senate Floor Session at 01:36:50, *available at* <https://www.azleg.gov/videoplayer/?eventID=2024051012>. This too is relevant to the entire Motion, as PPAZ asks this Court to honor legislative intent by withholding its mandate.
