O R D E R

Appellant Sanchez filed a "Notice of Appeal to the Arizona Supreme Court" along with a "Statement of Expedited Elections Matter" on August 5, 2022 and a copy of the August 3, 2022 minute entry entered in this case. In lieu of a scheduling conference, Court staff consulted with the parties to address the matters in ARCAP 10.

Appellant's counsel advises that he will file the transcript as soon as it is available, which should be this week.

Neither the County nor the City anticipate filing a brief in this matter.

IT IS ORDERED Appellant shall file the opening brief no later than 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 11, 2022. The opening brief shall be no more than 3500 words.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Appellee may file an answering brief no later than 4:00 p.m. on Monday, August 15, 2022. The answering brief shall be no more than 3500 words.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Appellant may file a reply brief no later than 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 17, 2022. The reply brief shall be no more than 1750 words.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Maricopa County or the City of Phoenix may file a brief either when the answering brief is due (to address the opening brief) or a response when the reply brief is due (to address the answering brief) and these briefs shall be no more than 3500 words.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that briefs will be in a legible 14-point font, double-spaced, and will include all arguments the parties wish to present to the Court. They may be filed in memorandum format (no tables of contents or authorities).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in addition to filing briefs with the Clerk of the Supreme Court (with filing and service through AZTurboCourt) all filings are also to be sent by email to all the parties and court staff and to SACrtDocs@courts.az.gov no later than the filing deadlines.

The Court anticipates that this matter will be considered without oral argument.
