I, Kori Lorick, declare as follows:

1. I am the State Elections Director in Secretary of State Katie Hobbs's Office. In this role, I oversee the Elections Services Division in the Department of State. I have served in this role since July 2021. Prior to that and since September 2019, I served as the Elections Compliance Manager in the Elections Services Division. In my current role as State Elections Director, my responsibilities include overseeing the Secretary of State's issuance of the statewide publicity pamphlet pursuant to A.R.S. § 19-123 and certification of initiatives to appear on the general election ballot.

2. To meet the operational and statutory deadlines to publish the statewide publicity pamphlet, our Office must finalize the publication by August 25, 2022.

3. Additionally, through consultation with the counties, we have learned that the earliest deadline among them to make changes to the general election ballot is Maricopa County's deadline of August 25, 2022. This deadline ensures that the County can meet subsequent deadlines for printing and mailing general election ballots to uniformed and overseas voters beginning September 24, 2022, pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-543(A) and 52 U.S.C. § 20302(a)(8).
