The Commission on Appellate Court Appointments will review the applications and hear comments at a public meeting on July 22, 2021. The meeting will be held in room 345 of the Arizona State Courts Building, 1501 W. Washington. Meeting details will be available on the public meeting notice. The public meeting notice and meeting agenda will be posted on the Commission's website at least seven (7) days prior to the meeting.

Citizens may address the Commission on the day of the meeting or send written comments to jnc@courts.az.gov or to 1501 W. Washington, Suite 221, Phoenix, AZ, 85007. It is not necessary to submit multiple copies of written comments, and email is preferred. Comments must be received no later than July 20, 2021 to be considered. Anonymous comments cannot be considered.

At the July 22, 2021 meeting, the Commission will choose the applicants to be interviewed. The selected applicants will be interviewed on August 9, 2021. The logistics of this meeting will be available after the July 22nd meeting. After the interviews, the Commission will recommend at least three nominees for the opening to Governor Doug Ducey, who will appoint the new judge.
