IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Appellees' answering brief is due no later than October 12, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any amicus curiae briefs may be filed no later than October 15, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the State's reply brief may be filed no later than October 20, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any response to amicus curiae briefs may be filed no later than October 20, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the briefs may be in memorandum format (no tables of contents or authorities) in a legible font (14-point), double-spaced, with the briefs to include all arguments the parties wish to present to the Court. The parties' opening and answering briefs will be no more than 5,000 words; amici briefs no more than 3,000 words; combined response briefs to amicus briefs no more than 3,000 words; and the reply brief no more than 1,500 words.
