Arizona Supreme Court Appoints New Supreme Court Clerk

PHOENIX – The Arizona Supreme Court named Tracie Lindeman as Clerk of the Supreme Court, effective March 15, 2021. Clerk Lindeman brings extensive court knowledge and experience to the position, including eight years as Clerk of the Nevada Supreme Court. In Nevada, the Clerk oversees clerk operations for the Supreme Court of Nevada and the Nevada Court of Appeals.

Chief Justice Robert Brutinel commented, “The Arizona Supreme Court enthusiastically welcomes Tracie Lindeman as the next Clerk of the Supreme Court. Her experience as the Clerk of the Nevada Supreme Court and her extensive appellate court and management background makes her an outstanding choice as our new Clerk.”

Clerk Lindeman received her undergraduate degree from Stanford University and her law degree from Gonzaga University School of Law and is a member of the bar in Nevada and California. She clerked for a trial judge and an appellate judge before working for 12 years as a staff attorney with the Nevada Supreme Court’s Central Legal Staff, including 10 years as supervising staff attorney. As the appointed Clerk of the Nevada Supreme Court, Lindeman managed the court’s caseload and docket; the administrative docket, including drafting court rules; and oversaw the publication of opinions, rules, and reports. Her management experience as Clerk included overseeing 10 attorneys and 15 non-attorney support staff. Since 2016, Clerk Lindeman has worked as a freelance attorney and as an appellate practice and procedure consultant.



Commenting on her appointment, Clerk Lindeman stated, “I am honored by this appointment and look forward to being of service to the Arizona Supreme Court and the State of Arizona.”
