IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that **MARY V. SCHAFFER**, a suspended member of the State Bar of Arizona, is hereby suspended from the practice of law for a period of four years, effective the date of this judgment and order, for conduct in violation of her duties and obligations as a lawyer, as disclosed in the Disciplinary Commission Report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **MARY V. SCHAFFER** shall be placed on probation for a period of two years upon reinstatement with terms and conditions to be determined at the time of reinstatement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **MARY V. SCHAFFER** shall pay restitution in the following amount:

\$164.00 to Pima County as Ordered in Case No. J-16122800

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall comply with all applicable provisions of Rule 72, Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona, and shall promptly inform this Court of her compliance with this Order as provided in Rule 72(e).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall comply with all rule provisions regarding reinstatement proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **MARY V. SCHAFFER** shall be assessed costs and expenses of the disciplinary proceedings as provided in Rule 60(b).
