Whereas, the Arizona Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2021-00077 in response to the changing conditions surrounding the current public health situation;

IT IS ORDERED that as of June 1, 2021 court personnel and all other persons entering the Santa Cruz County facility are no longer required to wear a face-covering in court facilities. The Court recommends continued use of face coverings for non-vaccinated persons, high-risk persons, or persons desiring to utilize a face covering.

All other safety measures will continue unless specifically changed by the direction of the Presiding Judge.

Due the limited space within the Nogales Municipal Court, and because of the number of persons entering that facility on a daily basis, and at the request of the Presiding Municipal Court Judge, it is ordered that all personnel and persons entering that facility are required to continue to use a face-covering, until further order of the undersigned Presiding Judge.


