Due to concerns for the spread of COVID-19 in the general population, the Governor of the State of Arizona has declared a statewide emergency pursuant to A.R.S. § 26-303 and in accordance with A.R.S. § 26-301(15).

In Administrative Order No. 2020-45, the Chief Justice ordered that the Administrative Director “may suspend the requirements of any section of the Code of Judicial Administration if he determines that public health emergency measures significantly impair the ability to operate the program or the parties governed by that code section.”

Therefore, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2020-45,

IT IS DIRECTED that the following requirement is suspended or modified as follows:

ACJA § 6-106: Personnel Practices

The random drug testing of employees who perform safety sensitive duties established in ACJA § 6-106(L)(1)(d) is suspended until June 1, 2020.
