Administrative Order No. 2016-16 was entered on March 3, 2016. The Order established the Task Force on Fair Justice for All (Task Force) to study and make recommendations regarding court-ordered fines, penalties, fees, and pretrial release policies. The Task Force presented its final report to the Arizona Judicial Council (“AJC”) in October 2016. The report recommended the filing of a petition requesting amendments to various Rules of Criminal Procedure, and the AJC unanimously supported this recommendation.

The Task Force anticipates filing a rule petition by January 10, 2017. The Task Force would thereafter review and respond to comments during the 2017 rule cycle. The Task Force’s term currently expires on January 1, 2017.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 2016-16 be amended to extend the term of the Fair Justice for All Task Force to August 31, 2017.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following member is appointed to the Task Force for a term beginning upon signature of this Order, and ending August 31, 2017.
