Administrative Order No. 2016-52 deferred an increase in annual membership fees required by this Court's Administrative Order No. 2014-89 from 2018 until 2019. The establishment and allocation of membership fees are controlled by Rule 32(c)(7) through (c)(10), Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court.

In consideration of the financial review and recommendations as to the current fiscal status of the State Bar of Arizona, the Board of Governors has advised this Court that the membership fee increase scheduled for 2019 is not necessary. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that there be no increase in any of the membership fee categories, beginning with the year of January 1, 2019, and each year thereafter until further Order of the Court.
