The Supreme Court, having administrative supervision over all courts of the state pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, periodically conducts reviews and audits of court operations.

The Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2020-161 on October 14, 2020, ordering administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Sierra Vista City Court be assumed by the Honorable James Conlogue, Presiding Judge of the Arizona Superior Court in Cochise County.

The Sierra Vista City Court appointed a Presiding Magistrate and a multi-year co-location agreement is now in place.

The Presiding Judge of Superior Court in Cochise County has advised that his continued administrative oversight is no longer warranted and recommends that administrative authority be returned to the new magistrate, effective immediately. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2020-161 be rescinded.
