Administrative Order No. 2020-10 was entered on January 8, 2020. The Order established the Family Court Improvement Committee, Child Support Guidelines Review Subcommittee to:

- Review and make recommendations regarding issues referred for further studies by the 2017 Committee for an Interim Review of the Child Support Guidelines.
- Make recommendations regarding other improvements to the guidelines.
- Consider economic and labor market data; the impact of guideline policies and amounts on custodial and noncustodial parents who have family incomes below 200 percent of the Federal poverty level, and factors that impact compliance with child support orders;
- Analyze case data on the application of and deviations from the child support guidelines, as well as the rates of default and imputed child support orders and orders determined using the low-income adjustment.
- Provide a meaningful opportunity for public input, including input from low-income custodial and noncustodial parents and their representatives.

The Subcommittee continues to examine issues that may result in proposed amendments to the Arizona Child Support Guidelines to be considered by the Arizona Judicial Council in April 2021.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 2020-10 be amended to extend the term of the Family Court Improvement Committee, Child Support Guidelines Review Subcommittee to April 30, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the term of service for the appointed members, in Appendix A, of the Family Court Improvement Committee, Child Support Guidelines Review Subcommittee be extended to July 31, 2021.
