A.R.S. § 41-1750(U)(10) requires certain criminal dispositions be reported to the central state repository of the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) on a form or in a manner specified by rules approved by the Supreme Court. Rule 37.1 of the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure requires that criminal dispositions be reported to DPS on a form approved by the Supreme Court. The form may be created and transmitted electronically.

Modifications to the Final Disposition Report form previously approved in Administrative Order No. 2002-33 have been made to implement the expungement of criminal convictions pursuant to A.R.S. § 36-2862. Courts that normally report dispositions electronically through the Arizona Disposition Reporting System (ADRS) shall report expungements manually on the form approved by this Order until further notice.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED the attached Final Disposition Report form is hereby approved for statewide use as of July 12, 2021. The Administrative Director may approve, on behalf of the Supreme Court, any substantial variation from the attached form.
