Pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative supervision over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts. It has come to the Court's attention that the Sedona Municipal Court has been without a presiding judge and currently has no judicial officer.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Sedona Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable John D. Napper, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Yavapai County, and Judge Napper shall assign judicial officers and administrative staff, as needed to conduct the court business. Judge Napper is also authorized to issue such orders as necessary for the court to operate properly

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until a successor assumes duties as Judge of the Sedona Municipal Court. Any cost associated with operating this court, including cost for judicial officers, shall be a city cost.
