On March 25, 2020, the Steering Committee on Data-Based Court Performance and Data Standards (the Committee) was established by Administrative Order No. 2020-53.

The Committee is charged with identifying court data that is needed to make data-based decisions related to case processing, court policy and management decisions, allocation of court resources, and data exchanges with other government entities. The committee is developing recommendations regarding what data elements need to be collected in each case type, data governance, and other steps needed to improve data quality. Lastly, the committee is reviewing Arizona case management data to assess conformance with the Supreme Court of Arizona's time standards and, as desirable, recommending adjustments to existing time standards.

An extension of the Committee's term of service is required for completion of the above-mentioned ongoing work.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the term of the Steering Committee on Data-Based Court Performance and Data Standards is extended to December 31, 2022.
