Administrative Order No. 2020-172 was entered on November 4, 2020. The order provided pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-332(B), the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in each county may authorize re-summoning of jurors who have previously been summonsed and met the term of service under A.R.S. § 21-332(A)(2), (3), (4) and (5) for a period of time commencing on issuance of this order through March 31, 2021.

Given the continued public health emergency, there is a need to extend this order for a longer period of time. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in each county may authorize re-summoning of jurors who have previously been summonsed and met the term of service under A.R.S. § 21-332(A)(2), (3), (4) and (5) through December 31, 2021.
