Pursuant to A.R.S. § 14-5651 and ACJA § 7-202, the Supreme Court established certain minimum fiduciary licensing requirements, including education and experience, applicants must have prior to licensure.

Having reviewed the unique circumstances of Mr. Strasburg’s application and experience and having received staff’s recommendation supporting the waiver, it is determined that, assuming compliance with the other licensure requirements of ACJA § 7-202, Mr. Strasburg’s experience is adequate to receive a good cause exception to the experience and education requirements of ACJA § 7-202.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED waiving the experience and education requirements for Mr. Strasburg as it relates to the initial certification.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Strasburg must satisfy all other requirements for licensure prior to being licensed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Mr. Strasburg is licensed, the Fiduciary Board shall restrict his license so that he may only serve as a conservator, personal representative, and/or trustee.
