To ensure prompt consideration of any legal dispute regarding voting on November 8, 2022, it is necessary to extend the hours of operation of the Superior Court in Arizona until the polls close that day.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, sections 3 and 23 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the Superior Court, including the Office of the Clerk of the Court, in each county shall remain available to accept filings on November 8, 2022 until all the polling locations in the county are closed to voters.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Judge in each county shall provide a phone number that can be used to contact the court on November 8th after 5:00 PM to the local county elections department, to the division of the Court of Appeals to which the Superior Court is assigned, the county attorney, and to the Administrative Office of the Courts.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Judge or designee in each county immediately notify the clerk of the applicable division of the Court of Appeals, the Supreme Court Clerk, and the Supreme Court's Public Information Officer in the event the court receives an election-related case.
