Prompted by health and safety concerns, Administrative Order No. 2020-51 allowed for remote appearances in certain proceedings of the Committee on Character and Fitness. The Court amended Rule 36(e)(2), Rules of the Supreme Court, effective January 1, 2023, to address the use of remote appearances more broadly. Therefore, the remaining provisions in Administrative Order No. 2020-51 have been superseded and are no longer needed after the end of the year.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Sections 3 and 5, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED terminating the remaining provisions of Administrative Order No. 2020-51 effective December 31, 2022.
