On March 25, 2020, this Court issued Administrative Order No. 2020-53, which established the Steering Committee on Data-Based Court Performance and Data Standards (“the Committee”). Through Administrative Order No. 2021-171, the Court extended the term of the Committee through December 31, 2022.

An extension of the Committee’s term is necessary for the Committee to continue its work on identifying court data that is needed to make data-based decisions, developing implementation recommendations regarding required data elements and improved data quality, and reviewing Arizona case management data to assess conformance with the Supreme Court of Arizona’s time standards.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the term of the Steering Committee on Data-Based Court Performance and Data Standards is extended to December 31, 2025.
