This Court entered Administrative Order No. 2020-183 on November 25, 2020, and established the Committee on Criminal Rules Regarding Victims. The Order directed the Committee to review the amendments proposed by rule petition No. R-20-0031, and after completing its review, to file its recommendations by May 28, 2021. The Order provided that the members' terms would end on December 31, 2021.

Administrative Order No. 2021-29 extended the time for the Committee to file its recommendations to October 1, 2021. Administrative Order No. 2021-182 further extended the time for the Committee to file its recommendations, and the members' terms, to July 1, 2022. The Committee recently filed its recommendations in rule petition No. R-20-0031. The Committee Chair thereafter filed a new rule petition, No. R-22-0035, concerning one of those recommendations.

The Court intends to open petition No. R-22-0035 for public comments. The Committee has requested an extension of its term to allow it to file a reply to any public comments. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the term of the Committee on Criminal Rules Regarding Victims is extended until December 31, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Committee members appointed by Administrative Orders No. 2020-183 and No. 2020-199 shall continue their service during the period of this extension. Their terms will end on December 31, 2022.
